19. In Hand Large Breeds – Open to in hand MM ponies registered with their respective pure bred societies; Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh Sec C & D to be shown in hand. Stallion Mare, Colt, Filly or gelding any age. *The Bob Lofthouse Salver*

23. Junior Ridden MM.—Mares or geldings 4 yrs old and over registered in their Respective pure bred stud book of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A,B,C,D. Riders of small breed not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders of large breeds not to have attained their 18th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Championship: 1st & 2nd from Classes 21 –23 to compete for Hart & Co Shield

24. Mountain and Moorland Lead Rein. Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their respective pure breed societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A & B. Mare or Gelding 4 yrs old and over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in snaffle bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

25. Mountain and Moorland First Ridden – Open to Mountain and Moorland Ponies registered with their prospective pure breed societies. Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A & B, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

26. **Young Handler** be shown in hand, MM or plaited, 12 yrs and under, Child must be suitable for the pony they are leading

27. **Diane Goodyear Class for Best Local Rider.** Open to Ridden Horses & Ponies, rider 16 years & under to reside strictly within a 8 mile radius of the Show field. Lead Rein welcome. Special Rosette for each entrant. *Diane Goodyear Memorial Trophy*

28. **Junior Equitation & Turnout** Open to Ridden Ponies up 153cm, rider 17 years & Under Lead Rein ponies welcome. *Tockwith Trailer Hire Trophy*

29. **Senior Equitation & Turnout** Open to Ridden Horses & Ponies, rider 18 years & Over
The Brooke Steels Trophy

30. **Bonny Pony**— in hand.

32. **Veteran Horse or Pony**, over 15 years to be shown in hand. *Machin Horse Trophy*

33. **Veteran Horse or Pony** over 15 yrs - Rider any Age but must be suitable for the size of horse/pony ridden. *Oasis Marquee Trophy*

34. **Lead Rein Pony** Plaited or MM. Ponies 4 yrs & over Not to exceed 128cm Rider 8 years and under. Rosettes and sweets to all competitors. Lead rein must be attached to noseband.

35. **Walk and Trot Class** ponies 4yrs old and over not to exceed 128cm Riders 10 and under This class is designed for children who are just coming off the lead rein. No cantering allowed. Children who are clearly beyond this level will be asked to leave the ring. COMETITORS IN THIS CLASS MAY NOT ENTER CLASS 36.

36. **Ridden Pony** mare or gelding 4 yrs & over Not to exceed 148cms Rider 17 yrs & under

37. **Ridden Horse** Mare or gelding 4yrs old and over exceeding 148cm, Riders any age but must be suitable for the height of horse being ridden.

38. **Novice Ridden Horse.** Mare or Gelding Hunter, Cob or Riding Horse type 4 years old & over exceeding 148cms not to have more than £30 in prize money before in any showing competition. Rider any age.

39. **Small Ridden Hunter** Mare or Gelding 4 years & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158 cm . Rider any age

40. **Ridden Hunter** Mare or Gelding 4 years & over, exceeding 153cms . Rider any age.

The C York Memorial Trophy

41. **Ridden Cob/Maxi Cob.** Mare or Gelding 4 years & over. Exceeding 148cms Must be hogged and trimmed. Rider any age. *The R & W Brown Trophy*

WORKING HUNTER PONIES

Judge: Mrs S Moncaster Ring two—not before 2.30pm

42. **Tiny Tots Working Pony**, Mare or gelding 4 yrs old and over not exceeding 128cms to be ridden by a child 12 and under – Lead rein optional
43. **Mountain and Moorland Working Hunter Pony** Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over. Ponies must be registered with their breed society. Riders and age must be the appropriate height for the pony they are riding. If entries warrant this class will be jumped in height sections
44. **Novice Working Hunter Pony** Not exceeding 153cms Rider 18 years & Under Ponies not to have more than £30 in prize money in any working hunter competition. If entries warrant this class will be jumped in height sections
45. **Working Hunter Pony/pony club pony**. Not exceeding 153cms Rider 18 yrs and under. If entries warrant this class will be jumped in height sections not to exceed 80cms

Championship 1st and 2nd from classes 42 - 45 to compete for The Hessay Trophy

COLOURED WORKING HUNTER/PONY

Judge: Mrs S Moncaster Ring two—not before 11.30am

46. **Coloured Working Hunter/Pony** – Mare or Gelding 4 yrs old and over – Any height, Rider any age – if sufficient entries this class will be split into horses over 153cms and ponies under 153cms Rider must be suitable for the size of horse/pony they are riding.

WORKING HUNTERS

Judge: Mr N Wakefield and Mrs C Haley Ring two—not before 12.30

47. **Novice Working Hunter** Open to horses over 153cm. Rider any age. Maximum height of fences 75cms. Horses not to have more than £30 in prize money in any working hunter competition.
48. **Open Working Hunter Horse** Mare or gelding. 4 yrs old and over exceeding 148cms. Rider any age.

Championship: 1st & 2nd from Classes 47 & 48 to compete for The Tockwith Horse Trophy

49. **Racehorse to Riding Horse**—Unaffiliated class for TB Mare or gelding 4 yrs old and over that has been in training, but not necessarily raced on the track—Rider to be over 16 yrs of age. To be judged on way of going. Horses will not be ridden by the judge.
